Introduction

Jimmy Mackey introduced himself and asked other attendees to identify themselves also.

Schedule Review

Paul Sauerborn reviewed the 2002 schedule and asked that if anyone had additional items to be reviewed to tell Mr. Mackey or Mr. Sauerborn of the topics in order that they be reviewed for addition.

CAB Rec. Status Update for #7, 86, 87, 122, 134 and 145

Mr. Mackey led the discussion on the CAB recommendation status and with little discussion the following updates were made:

- **#7 Tritium Health Effects Study** – moved from Open to Closed with a request that the Consortium for Risk Evaluation with Stakeholder Participation send a letter identifying the results of their study and any future action that may be taken.
- **#86 Old Radioactive Waste Burial Ground Corrective Measures Study (CMS) / Feasibility Study (FS)** – moved from Open to Closed which is appropriate due to the conclusion of the Old Radioactive Waste Burial Ground Focus Groups studies.
- **#87 Old Radioactive Waste Burial Ground Permit Modification** – moved from Open to Closed, with a request that the ER Committee be appraised of all future permit modifications.
- **#122 Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL)** – will remain Open and the ER Committee is currently requesting an update on this subject at one of the next ER Committee meetings.

- **#134 Water Quality Standards 2000 Revisions – will remain Open and is the ER Committee is currently requesting an update on this subject at one of the next ER Committee meetings.**
- **#145 Groundwater Mixing Zones – moved from Open to Closed.**

Public Comment

Jimmy Mackey took time to inquire about the Consolidation Units. Rod Rimando explained that these are operable units being combined into one unit for the following reasons.

- **Consolidation Unit - Warner's Pond, HP52 outfall, H-Area Retention Basin**
- **All are located near Fourmile Branch**
- **All contain Principle Threat Source Material (PTSM)**

The proposed action would be to excavate the PTSM and place it in the ORWBG over the 22 grouted tanks and ultimately a final cover will be placed over the top of the fill.

Mr. Mackey stated that he would miss the support that Maria Reichmanis has provided to the ER Committee and the CAB, and wishes her well as she leaves the CAB and her position as Vice Chair of the ER Committee.

There were no other comments made and the meeting was adjourned.
